- A. LT Devlin reported to the committee that LPD has successfully passed our on-site inspection for accreditation with the PA Chiefs of Police Association. The team of assessors will issue a final report in the coming weeks.**
- B. LT reported to the committee that the chief and our Traffic Engineer have been working to review plans to increase traffic flow in the downtown area by removing the one-way street designations for Courtland Street and Susquehanna Ave**
- C. LT Devlin advised the committee that the draft 2022 budget was sent to the borough and while there were many small increases over 2021's budget, however overall, the increase was approximately 4.3% over the 2021 budget.**
