Capital Projects & Financial Stewardship: Investing wisely in our parks system

- Major capital improvements delivered in 2025
- Projects focused on accessibility, safety, and long-term reinvestment
- Significant grant funding leveraged to reduce costs
- Strong interdepartmental partnerships



White's Road Park Restroom Facility: A small facility with a big impact

- New restroom facility with water & sewer service
- Interdepartmental collaboration (WWTP, PW, Electric, Facilities)
- \$269k in grant funding secured (2024 and 2025)
- Borough investment: \$70k
(Total project value: \$335k)



White's Road Pool Renovation:

Major reinvestment in a beloved community asset

- Phase I Completed Spring 2025: \$1.1M
 - Main Pool: Plaster, slides, diving board, retiling ADA ramp, shade sails, new drain and valves
- Phase II Underway: \$2.1M
 - Baby and Intermediate Pools
 - Expected completion: May 2026



W. 5th Street Playground Rehabilitation: Play, access, and safety upgrades

- New playground & safety surfacing
- ADA parking area & basketball court resurfacing
- New fencing, benches & shade sail
- Grants and donations secured: \$463k
- Borough investment: \$42k (Total project value: \$505k)



Trail Paving Project: Improving access, safety & connectivity

- York & Susquehanna Park
- Memorial Park
- Wissahickon Park
- 8' wide multi-modal trails
- Montco 2040 Grant: \$250k
- Borough investment: \$80k



Traffic Garden at Wedgewood Park: Teaching safety through play

- Fully reimbursed county and state program
- Painted roadway on underutilized asphalt pad
- Hands-on learning for biking and pedestrian safety



Comprehensive Parks, Recreation & Open Space Plan

- First department-specific comp. update since 1972
- Community-driven evaluation of programs, facilities, maintenance, staffing, and open space
